How To Respond When God Speaks A Personal Word To You Principles and Practices for Fulfilling Your Personal Prophecy

LOGOS or RHEMA:

Principles are the same for proper response in obtaining your prophetic promise: Faith; Obedience; Diligence; Dedication; Revelation; Personal Relationship with Christ; Christ-Like Attitude; Make Any Necessary Adjustments; Patience and Divine Flexibility.

PROPER RESPONSE TO PERSONAL PROPHECY:

- 1. Record (write it out) Read Your Word Each Month-Meditate Upon It 1 Timothy 4:14, 15 -understand, relate, receive
- 2. Witness To and Then Wage a Good Warfare with Your Prophecy. Romans 8:16 and 1Timothy 1:18
- 3. Do Nothing Different Unless Definitely Directed.
 (David) 1 Samuel 16:13; (Jehu) II Kings 9; (Jehoshaphat) II
 Chronicles 20 If Definitely Directed, Follow All Directions to Detail.
- 4. Remove the Hindrances of: Mindsets; Soul Blockages; Poor Selfimage; Pride; Blame-shifting; Self-preservation; People Pleasing; Carnal Reasoning and Procrastination. Hebrews 2:1; 12:1, 2; I Samuel 13, 15. Four soils: break-up the ground and remove any weeds (Matthew 13:18-23)
- 5. Wait Patiently upon the Fulfillment of the Prophetic Word. Isaiah 40:31; Psalm 27:14 & 37:7, Hosea 12:6; Hebrews 6:11, 12
- 6. Remember God is More Concerned with Your Character. Man/Woman Must be Made Before a Mighty Ministry. Hebrews 2:6-10
 Jesus: 30 years preparation and 3 years ministry = 10:1 ratio
- 7. There are Consequences to Not Waiting Long Enough.
 Abraham and Sarah produced Ishmael; Saul Negated His Prophecy
- 8. Receive Your Prophetic Word with Faith, Humility, Meekness and Vision. Hebrews 4:2; Deuteronomy 29:29; Matthew 21:21; Psalm 34:2
